Croydon: Open access print rooms - front door fob access (£25 returnable deposit)

ASC Art House main entrance (both) - door code (for kitchen, toilet and breakout space)

Vauxhall: Open Access print rooms: entry system via phone application

Croydon members will need to purchase a fob which provides secure access to the print studio.

Door codes and website members area password will be given at your induction.

INDUCTIONS:

You must have had a studio induction before you can book open access sessions, so you understand how the studio is set up enabling you to be able to print independently going forward (to become a member you will need to have had sufficient experience in your chosen print technique to work independently). The induction session will also include your first open access session (so there will be 7 or 3 remaining open access sessions available to book after your induction). Please bring something you would like to work on, paper and inks.

Please email info@bainbridgeprint.com to arrange your first session which also includes your studio induction.

We generally offer inductions on these days:

Croydon: Mondays & Thursdays

Vauxhall: Saturdays & some weekdays

STUDIO MEMBERSHIP

The studio membership year runs from January to December. New members automatically pay the studio membership fee when joining (pro rata). Studio membership is charged at £60 per year (equivalent to £5 per month) and is payable by the end of January of the new membership year. This pays for the storage the studio offers to all open access members. Desk and studio holders are exempt from this charge. If an existing member does not renew their membership by the end of January of the new year they will need to collect all their belongings and use any existing sessions before then.

BOOKING SESSIONS

Session booking is available to printers who either have previous experience or have completed a workshop that is a minimum of two days in duration. This is to ensure equipment is used properly and safely and that printmakers are getting the most out of their sessions.

Session Times - Croydon

- Morning (am), 8:30am 1:30pm
- Afternoon (pm), 1:30 6.30pm
- Evening (eve), 6:30 1:.30pm



Session Times - Vauxhall

- Morning (am), 8:30am 1:30pm
- Afternoon (pm), 1:30 6:30pm

In some circumstances, extended hours can be arranged in advance. Please note that this is at the studio's discretion.

Please note:

- Time shown indicates when the session begins
- Each session is 5 hours in duration, although you are welcome the prepare and clean up either side of this
- For a whole day book 2 individual sessions, either morning/afternoon or afternoon/evening
- You can book a session up to 2 weeks in advance
- If you need to reschedule or cancel your session, you can do this up to 12 hours before the start.

If you are a new member - during your induction the studio will set you up on the booking system which will generate a certificate code, so you can book future sessions via the website, the code will be emailed to you.

BOOKING FIRST SESSION VIA THE WEBSITE


To book a session navigate to the Members area of the website (password will be provided at your induction).


- click on 'Schedule Appointment'
- click on 'Redeem Coupon, Package or Gift Certificate'
- enter your certificate code
- providing you have sufficient sessions left that haven't expired this will reset the cost to £0
- select session type for either Croydon or Vauxhall studio
- select date and time
- type in your name and phone number
- click 'Complete session booking'

You'll get an email confirmation of your booking - where it's also possible to cancel or reschedule (up to 12 hours before your session begins).



After booking a session it will give you the option of creating an account. You don't have to create one but if you do you'll get the following benefits – it will remember your name, telephone and email address each time you book and show your upcoming appointments (as long as you were logged in when you booked them.) It will also show any remaining hours you have left of Open Access.





If you create a login - remember to login first before you book your next appointment.

OPEN ACCESS SESSIONS - STUDIO CARE

After your session:

- Please leave as you find it
- Clean thoroughly and return all equipment to it's home ready for the next user
- Wipe all surfaces used
- Mop excess water in wash-out room

Before you leave:

- Ensure radiators and fans are switched off and the door is locked

House rules:



- If screen printing you must use the ready mixed studio emulsion (please don't bring in your own) and pay for what you've used via the online Materials Shop.
- No groups or individuals to be in the print rooms during your session unless pre-arranged. This is for the purpose of safety and out of respect for other members and residents.
- You are very welcome to use the speaker provided to play music or radio, but please be mindful of others using the print rooms and in the studio spaces upstairs.



The studio provides screens in a range of sizes which you are welcome to use. We do ask that they are cleaned and de-coated ready for the next person at the end of each session. Each open access member will have a box to store inks and other bits at the studio to save carrying in each session.

NOTE: YOU MUST USE THE STUDIO EMULSION PROVIDED FOR SCREEN PRINTING & PAY FOR WHAT YOU'VE USED VIA THE ONLINE MATERIALS SHOP (We do not allow members to bring in their own emulsion as this affects exposure timings).

- Print medium for paper and fabric

- Acid free tissue paper (x20 sheets)
- Brown tape / Masking tape
- Plastic tubs with lids for mixing ink
